Minutes

I. CALL TO ORDER

Members present were: Dave Dickson, Sharon Penn, Tina Bergstrom and Superintendent Frank Walter. Also in attendance were Carol Johnson, North Olympic Timber Action Committee, Bill Peach, Rayonier, and Justin Knobel. Rick Wagner, Chief, Columbia-Cascades Land Resources Program Center National Park Service joined the meeting by conference call. The meeting was called to order at 6:15 P.M.

II. DISCUSSION OF THE OLYMPIC NATION PARK DRAFT GENERAL MANAGEMENT PLAN

Dave Dickson lead the discussion of the points of the Draft General Management Plan (DGMP). Frank Walter presented data regarding the funding the school district receives from timber lands. Rick Wagner joined the discussion by telephone at 6:30. Members of the board and audience asked question of Rick Wagner for approximately one and half hours. After the phone call, the board discussed the financial implications to the district, the historical expansion of the park in the West End, and the indirect effects expansion of the park would have on the district and community.
